## Application Instructions...

### 1. Clean & Dry

Before applying concealers, clean the area of skin you wish to cover with warm soapy water and dry.

### 2. Neutralising Concealers

The high colour pigment within our neutralising concealers provides a strong long lasting colour for up to 24 hours. To be used on the area you wish to cover such as a birthmark or scar. These Neutralisers are used to block out the colour to make the blemish disappear. If your blemish is not highly coloured you can go straight to the Finishing colours and use these as your first coat instead.



There are 2 neutralising concealers - Apricot and Ivory. Try both colours on your blemish to see which hides the colour best. It's different for every skin tone. You may want to mix your own colour using both concealers, play around until you are happy with the colour blocking.

Use the spatula to place a little neutralising concealer on your palm or back of your hand to soften the texture and make it easier to apply.

Take small amounts of the colour onto the concealer brush and apply over the area using short strokes. Add layers until you are satisfied that the colour of has been blocked out.

Finish off by taking some powder onto the powder puff and rolling it across the covered area. The rolling of the powder puff onto the area will help you to cover the area evenly without smudging the concealer. Dust off excess powder using the mini brush provided.

### 3. Finishing Colours

In each Cover Secret Kit you will find Finishing Colours (light or Medium) that contain high colour pigments for long lasting coverage. Apply Finishing Colours to achieve a natural match to your skin tone. Play around with the colours to find out which works best.



As in Step 2, use the spatula to place a little finishing concealer on the palm or back of your hand to soften the texture and make it easier to apply.

Take small amounts of the colour onto the concealer brush and apply over the area using short strokes. Add layers until you are satisfied with the coverage and colour match with your skin.

To achieve a natural finish blend the edges carefully with the skin around it. In some cases if the area is very hairy you may want to shave it before you start.

It is recommended that you powder between every few layer of colour but the amount of powder required will depend on your skin type and the blemish you are covering so experiment with the right balance of colour and powder.

### 4. Setting Colours

Cover Secret Finishing Powder is light and easy to apply. It sets your cover with a natural and water resistant finish. Gently roll on with the puff provided and dust off excess. Suitable for all skin tones.



## Cover Secret Top Tips...

- Always apply your make up in an area of natural light.
- You can mix the colours on your hand to get the perfect skin tone match. This also helps the product glide easily onto your skin as it has time to warm up.
- To find the best neutralising colour to block out the colour from your tattoo or blemish, don't be afraid to play around with all the colours to find the perfect match.
- If your blemish is not highly coloured you can go straight to the Finishing colours and use these as your first coat instead.
- You may find different colours works better on different areas of your body or on different blemishes.
- Don't be afraid to play around with the colours, mixing them to find what works best for you .
- You may need to shave hairy areas in order to create a smooth surface to apply the camouflage cream.
- Allow some time, practice makes perfect!
